



The two old cottages Svänö and Lövö are situated inside the beauty nature of the Store Mosse Nationalpark. There is a possibility to rent a bed or the whole cottage. It is a exotic accommodation without any electricity and running water from the tap. Water is picked up from the well and cooking can be made on the stove. Fully equipped kitchen which is available for all guests in the cottage.

In almost every room there are fireplaces to heat up. There are two toilets each nearby. Wood in the woodshed. There are 16 beds at Lövö and 24 beds at Svänö. There are pillows, quilts and blankets. Take you own bedlinen or sleepingbags with you (can also be rent if you like to).

We recommend sleeping bags during the cold period because the cottage might have been empty for some time before the heat pushes away the cold in the walls.

**Lövö** is in the south direction of the Store Mosse Nationalpark. You can drive to the gate of Lövö or you can hike from Naturum which is along road 151 going through the Nationalpark.

You hike over the bog and forest covered sand dunes or rocks as we call them. These rocks you find on many places throughout the Nationalpark.



**Lövö** is a morainehill from sand , gravel and stone who was built during the latest icemelting. Around this morainehill it has been built many sand dunes and rocks.

Lövö was built in the 16th century. In 1912, 4 farmerfamilies lived at Lövö. Today there is just one dwelling house left. Both cottages are carefully renovated and is a suitable cottage for you who will explore the Nationalpark nearby. The youthhostel has 16 beds in 4 rooms. The dwelling house is surrounded by grazing fields in an open landscape.

Sense of old times are visible through parts from old boxes, field patches, grazing fields, stonewalls and house plots. From the highest point in the landscape you can see how the big highbog spreads out and devours almost the little isle.

**Svänö** is like a small Island in the northern part of the Store Mosse Nationalpark. You can get there by car.

If you choose hiking you follow the path Kävsjön runt. You can start from the old church of Kävsjö or from Naturum which is placed along the road 151. If you follow the watch dials you follow the old churchpath which went through Södra Svänö Norregård.

Norregård where the youthhostel is situated was built in 1907 but here has humans been lived since the 16th century. Time has stand still. An unique feeling of silence prevails here with a beautiful nature and a rich selection of animals just around the corner.

Farming ended around 1940 but cows are still kept in the fields and surroundings to keep the landscape living through grazing.



The youth hostel has 24 beds in 4 rooms. You can rent a room from the lady of Svänö near the kitchen, where we have a familybunkbed.

The saga is that the lady of Svänö, also called the gray lady of Svänö is visible because she stayed to guard the silver treasure who was buried at Hanö.

A man from the village buried the silver from the church of Kävsjö there when the danish army plundered the place. Unfortunately he did never tell exactly where before he died.
